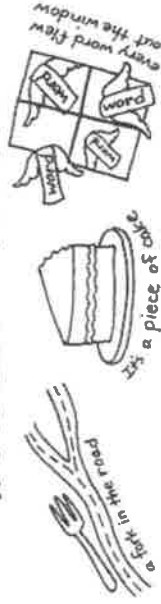
You be the Teacher! While reading every night for 20 minutes use the anchor charts below to guide your reading. Parents have a discussion of other playful languages you hear while reading or talking.
