. What is technical theatre?

Technical theatre is all of the behind the scenes work in theatre. This is the crew of sound, lights, set construction, painting, design, marketing, etc. Usually people who enjoy the theatre, but do not want to be on stage enjoy technical theatre.

· Will we be synchronous or asynchronous?

- Everyone will be synchronous except 7th period. 7th period production theatre will occasionally be asynchronous when we begin to work on shows. This will be communicated well in advance. The first three weeks everyone will be synchronous.
- Will we be able to perform this year?

- Yes! Many of my classes have periodic performances. Depending on the climate we may be producing virtual shows, live streamed shows, or socially distanced in person shows. We will continue to monitor the situation, and I have options ready for various scenarios.
- What will class look like for the first 3 weeks?
 - The first few weeks we will get to know each other, become comfortable with our online tools, and begin/review the basics of theatre. Active participation will be expected through the chat feature, games, and projects.
