

SFISD Fine Arts Musical Covid-19 Procedures

This document will be updated frequently as we encounter and solve new challenges.

GUIDELINES FOR EXTRACURRICULAR REHEARSAL

- Rehearsal groups will be coordinated by SFISD musical staff to minimize exposure when applicable.
- All students will self-screen daily before coming to rehearsals.
- Students who did not attend school in person due to symptom related issues will not be allowed to attend in person rehearsals.
- Students will NOT rehearse and stay home if they answered “YES” to any screening questions or if they do not feel well.
- If a student develops symptoms, the symptomatic student will be isolated and sent home, and all students in his/her group will be separated from symptomatic student.
- SFISD recommends the symptomatic student be tested as soon as possible and the results communicated with the teacher to initiate quarantine procedures.
- ALL students and teachers will wear masks during the rehearsal process, unless we are outside and socially distanced or actively participating in auditions/rehearsals/performance.
- Students will have assigned seats in the auditorium/ practice areas.
- Limit physical contact with others. Do not shake hands, hug, fist-bump or high five. Choreography and blocking will be designed to limit physical contact.
- Students will use hand sanitizer before entering the facility, and during rehearsal as needed.
- Supplies such as make up and costumes will be sanitized in between each rehearsal/performance and not shared between actors.
- Each actor will have a tub to hold their belongings. All of their supplies will be sanitized and in the tub after each rehearsal/ performance. Only specialty costumes that need to be hung will be left out of the tub. Hung costumes will be stored in garment bags.
- All tools, paint, other technical supplies will be sanitized between each use.
- Restrooms – Students are required to wash hands; utilize the “one in one out” model; sanitize hands after exiting; trash cans will be placed near doors to encourage students to open the door with the paper towel used to dry hands.
- All frequently touched areas such as door knobs will be disinfected periodically throughout rehearsals.

SELF and STUDENT SCREENING - DAILY

Every student will have screening questions regarding COVID-19 symptoms. If a student answers “YES” on any question they will stay at home and immediately communicate with their director to let them know.

Screening questions:

- Any contact with person who is/was positive for COVID-19; or
- New or worsening cough or shortness of breath/difficulty breathing; or
- Fever (subjective or >99.6); or
- At least one of: chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, diarrhea.
