STUDENT COMPUTER CONTRACT

Below are policies that will regulate our use of the computers, internet and email in Santa Fe ISD classrooms. These rules are designed to keep our computer and classroom functioning at the highest of standards. In order to have access to e-mail, the internet, and computers in the classrooms, please read the following and sign below.

RULES:

1. Students should not have any food or drinks on the desk where the computer will be used.
2. Computers should be used to access only the programs the teacher allows and used only for educational purposes.
 - a. Games, MySpace, Facebook, Internet Games, Youtube, chat rooms, Instant Messengers, Blog Websites, Fantasy Football/Basketball, etc are **NOT permitted!**
 - b. School email is for educational use ONLY.
3. Students may not under any circumstances install software or download music onto the computers.
4. Students may not plug anything into the USB, including cell phones or cell phone charging cables.
5. Students hacking, altering unauthorized files, or using the network in any way other than that intended will lose their computer privileges.
6. Any behavior which threatens the physical safety of the equipment or other students will lead to the loss of privileges.
7. Students may not give their passwords to other students.
8. Students may not change their desktop, screensaver, etc.
9. Students should save on their OneDrive/Office 365 Account only.
10. Students should inspect their computer every time they use it and immediately inform the teacher if anything is wrong.

CONSEQUENCES:

1st offense: Call home

2nd offense: 1-hour after school detention

3rd offense: Office referral

4th offense: Loss of use

These policies and procedures must be adhered to, and any violations of them will be met with zero tolerance.

- Students must abide by their signed contracts.
- The use of the computer is *a privilege, not a right*.
- If this contract is broken, the student's privilege will be revoked.
