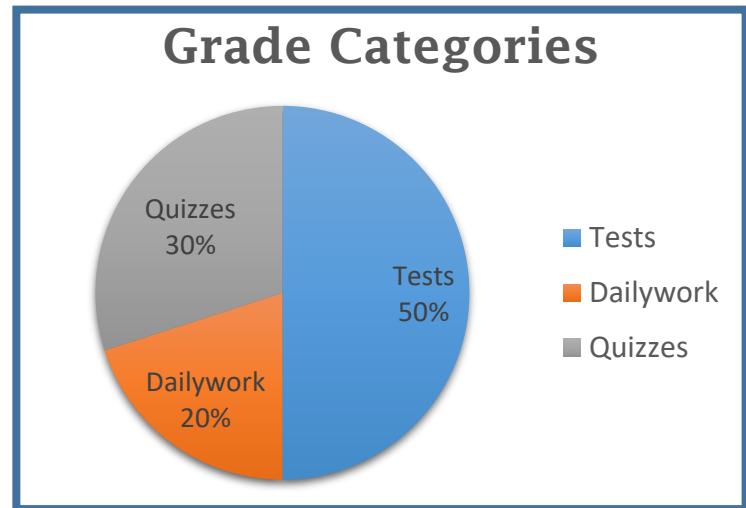
❖ Late work
